Home Security While You Are On Vacation Checklist

- Secure Doors and Windows** - Ensure all doors and windows are locked and secure before leaving. Install security locks and reinforcement plates if needed.
- Set Up Timer for Lights** - Install timers to turn on and off lights at different times each day to simulate someone being home.
- Put Hold on Mail and Newspapers** - A pile of newspaper or an overflowing mailbox can signal that no one is home. Contact the post office to hold mail deliveries.
- Secure Valuables Inside the Home** - Keep all valuables hidden so that they cannot be seen from outside, or lock them in a safe.
- Unplug all Non-Essential Electrical Devices** - Unplug all devices that won't be needed while you're gone to prevent potential damage from power surges or fires.
- Trim Landscape** - Make sure your landscape is clear and well-trimmed, as overgrown trees and plants can provide covers for burglars.
- Lock Up Garage** - Secure the garage door and lock any door leading from the garage to inside your home
- Adjust Thermostat** - Adjust your thermostat to a temperature consistent with the time of year to save energy while you're gone.
- Turn Off Watermain** - If you're going to be away for an extended period, consider turning off your water main to prevent potential flooding or leaks.
- Remove Any Spare Keys You Have Hidden** - Don't leave spare keys under doormats or pots. Leave them with a trusted neighbor or family member.
- Lock All Gates** - If you have a fenced in yard, ensure all gates are locked securely.
- Activate Security System** - Install a reliable security system that includes alarms, motion sensors, and security cameras. Ensure it's activated before leaving.
- Make Sure Home Insurance** - Make sure that your homeowners or renters insurance is up-to-date and fully covers your assets.
- Advise Neighbors** - Letting any trusted neighbors know of your travel plans helps add layer of security.
- Have a Vehicle Parked in Driveway** - Homes with cars in their driveway look less vulnerable to criminals.
